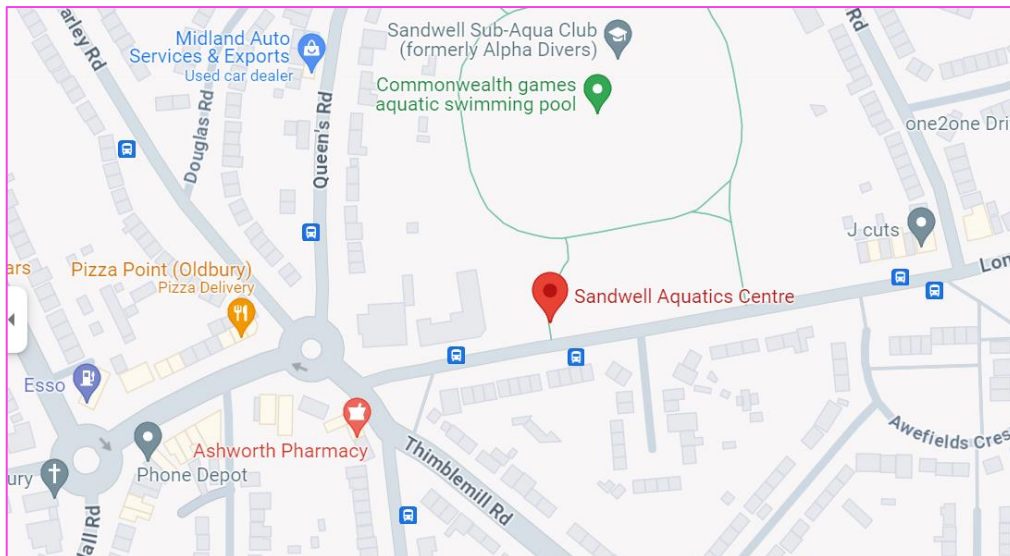

The technical meeting will take place at **13:00 on Thursday 23rd May** in the training room at Sandwell Aquatics Centre.

DIVE SHEETS

Divers/Coaches are requested to submit dive sheets electronically, both for their own convenience and to minimize the chance of errors loading the data into the Recording program. Coaches may make bulk submission of dive sheets on behalf of their divers by using the program DiveSheets with which they will already be familiar. Alternatively, individual divers may submit their own dive sheets online. Please agree with your coach which method you should use. To submit your dive sheets online there are two options:

Electronic dive sheets must be submitted where possible. Electronic submissions must be made by 18:00 on Tuesday 21st May 2024. You will be asked to sign hard copies of these sheets at the venue, available from the Recorders.

If neither you nor your Coach are able to use the above electronic methods, you can submit a hard copy of your lists of dives to the Recorders at Plymouth Life Centre.

If manual dive sheets need to be submitted, submissions must be made by 2 hours before the Technical Meeting.

For late entries, please do not submit a dive sheet until the late entry has been submitted and processed.

EVENT CONDITIONS

Event Conditions for Speedo Aquatics GB Diving Championships

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 British teams with British eligible divers have unlimited number of entries, but they must have achieved the respective qualification standard in the preceding 12 months (See Table 1.2).
- 1.2 Members of International Federations who are also members of British clubs may enter under their British Club, but will follow rules 3.1-3.3
- 1.3 Individual events will follow World Aquatic conditions (See Table 1.1) for 3m springboard and 10m platform. All platform dives to be performed from the 10m platform.
- 1.4 No dive may be repeated in a list of dives.
- 1.5 The minimum age for competitors is 10 years as of 31 December in the year of competition.
- 1.6 All Synchronised events will be straight finals.
- 1.7 Late Entries for all events are allowed up to the start of the Technical Meeting, subject to 1.1 above. All late entries will incur a late entry fee. The late entry fee for Synchro will be at the discretion of Aquatics GB Events Department.
- 1.8 Divers may compete exclusively in synchronised events.

2. FINALS

- 2.1 Divers will perform their dives, competing in the reverse order of their preliminary rankings.
- 2.2 The finals will consist of 12 divers, ranked from the preliminary event, at least 6 of which must be British divers.
- 2.3 Up to 6 international divers may proceed to the final, but only if they rank in the top 12 in the preliminary event.
- 2.4 Following condition (3), the remaining places in the final will be comprised of additional British divers in ranked order. This may include British divers originally ranked outside the top 12 in the preliminary event.

3. GUESTS (International Federation entries)

- 3.1 Evidence shall be provided, at the time of entry, to confirm that each international diver has achieved the qualifying standard for the event they are entering.
- 3.2 Multiple club entries from one country will be treated as one International Federation for final qualification purposes.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation for all competitors and coaches will be photographic. There will be security present at the event and in order to enter both the seating and field of play area you will need accreditation. All divers will be required to submit a **recent passport sized photo** with their online entry. Failure to supply a photograph with the entry forms will result in the entry forms being invalid and therefore not accepted.

If you need to re-print your accreditation on site, a charge of £10.00 applies. Please also note that the event is cashless and only card payment will be accepted on site.

COACH/CHAPERONE PASSES

All coaches, chaperones and physiotherapists must have a valid photo to gain access to the pool deck. Applications for coach/chaperone passes will be charged at £10 per event. **A valid DBS check, coaching and safeguarding qualification is required. Coach pass applications are now open [here](#).**

Applicants are advised the online Disclosure & Barring Service process could take up to 1 month to complete. All applicants must be registered with a Swim England affiliated club. All Swim England clubs and license applicants will have to complete a DBS (CRB) application regardless of any previous check carried out through another organisation unless this has been registered with the DBS Update Service www.gov.uk/dbs-update-service.

If you hold a disclosure that has been registered with the DBS Update Service, and you have not yet given the Swim England written consent to check the status, please submit your original disclosure certificate along with a completed consent form to dbs@swimming.org. Please also email dbs@swimming.org for a DBS Update Service Consent form.
